The anniversary celebration will begin with a 5k and "fun run" at 7:30 a.m., departing from the Christ Cathedral campus and traveling down Chapman, circling Pioneer Park in Garden Grove and returning to the campus. An outdoor Mass for more than five thousand will begin at 9:30am, followed by carnival games and sledding on real snow at 11 a.m. The highlight of the day will be a music festival beginning at 3:30 p.m. featuring performances by Matt Maher, Colton Dixon, Phil Wickham, Andy Mineo, Jordan Feliz, and Jackie Francois.
