Marriage Enrichment Through Communication, Faith, And Community

Calling Married Couples

Come together with other married couples who want to grow in their love for each other and their Catholic faith. This is a time to enrich your marriage through communication, faith, and fellowship with other married couples.

Objective

Provide an opportunity for married couples to grow in their love for each other, live closer and more faithfilled lives. and gain the support and friendship of other couples in living their Catholic faith.

Approach

The evening consists of a presentation given by a married couple in the Marriage Enrichment Ministry, followed by a time for personal reflection, and private sharing by spouses with each other.

An opportunity is then provided for learning from other couples in the group. The presentations are practical experiences of the presenting couple as they live their marriage. Handouts are provided that summarize the key points of the presentation and provide useful information for continued discussion at home. The evening ends with prayer, refreshments and open fellowship. Couples recognize their marriage is a journey shared with and supported by others.

Topics

Topics for each session are selected from a list of topics of interest to the participating couples. Topics include communication in marriage, living our Catholic faith, and meeting the challenges from being married and raising a family in the modern world.

Each topic is intended to affirm the ways we enrich our marriage and help us to improve where we can do better. Each couple draws from the evening what they want; no one offers advice about how to live the marriage of others, since each marriage relationship is unique.

Who Can Attend

Open to married couples of all ages and years married who want to live their marriage in the faith tradition of the Catholic Church.
