<u>POSITION TITLE</u>: Coordinator of Youth Ministry and Evangelization and supporting the Confirmation Sacramental Program

FLSA STATUS: Exempt - Salaried (Benefit Eligible)

SALARY RANGE: \$66,700 - \$70,000 - Salaried (Benefit Eligible)

REPORTS TO: Pastor

PRIMARY PURPOSE: The Coordinator of Youth Ministry and Evangelization is a passionate and active Catholic; with a desire to minister and serve the young people and their families of Nuestra Señora del Pilar through leading and managing a comprehensive strategy and outreaches, engages and evangelizes middle school and high school age youth and families with adolescents. Additionally, this position would support and co-lead the Confirmation sacramental program. This is a full-time exempt position that will include evenings and weekends.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

REQUIRED:

- Practicing Catholic with knowledge of and experience in middle school ministry, youth ministry, parent and family ministry and Confirmation preparation programs
- Strong organizational and communication skills with ability to multi-task and attention to detail; including small and large events
- Excellent writing, spelling and grammar skills and experience writing articles, announcements, short messages, blog entries, website, and other materials
- Ability to work both independently and collaboratively in a team setting and environment
- 3-5 years of successful experience working with youth in a professional setting.
- Bachelor's Degree in Theology, Religious Studies or related field
- Proficiency in Microsoft Office including Word, Excel, Outlook, Publisher etc. and some basic website editing and managing social media
- Effective public speaking skills and ability to facilitate large and small groups
- Valid California Driver's License
- Bilingual English / Spanish



DESIRED:

- Advanced computer skills in websites, marketing and/or graphic designs
- Ability to design curricula and develop programs
- Master's Degree in Theology or Certificate in Youth Ministry or equivalent (i.e., Theology Certificate, Biblical Studies, Master Catechist etc.)

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

- 1. Plan, oversee and coordinate the Middle School and High School Ministry and the Parish Confirmation Program, including registration, creating proper curriculum, and training facilitators and catechists.
- 2. Design and implement the method to track attendance at every activity, ensuring engagement and participation.
- 3. Create and coordinate a communications plan for all parents and sponsors of confirmation students. A communications plan should inform, remind and promote a healthy spiritual life which in turn should lead to healthy family faith life.
- 4. Recruit, train, and empower volunteers to be facilitators, catechists, retreat leaders and mentors to the middle school and high school youth.
- 5. Plan, coordinate, and evaluate classes, XLT's, bible studies and/or parent nights in collaboration with other staff members in the parish.
- 6. Ensure that all safe environment guidelines are being adhered to and in compliance with the implementation of The National Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.
- 7. Be aware and prepared to assist young people and their families in any pastoral care need that may arise from difficult topics and/or from personal sharing.
- 8. Attend, participate and represent the parish at all approved diocesan gatherings for youth and at all diocesan leadership meetings.
- 9. Post regular and relevant content on social media accounts and web pages
- 10. Plan and implement logistics for hosting parish youth events, confirmation ceremony along with rehearsals and printing of program.
- 11. Plan, prepare, implement, and manage the youth ministry and confirmation program budget.
- 12. Collaborate with other staff members and create spaces for everyone to serve middle school and high school age youth.
- 13. Perform other work-related tasks as assigned.
