PRIMARY PURPOSE: The Coordinator of Youth & Young Adult Ministry and Evangelization is a passionate and active Catholic; with a desire to minister and serve the young people (ages 11-18) and their families, as well as younger young adults (ages 18-25) of Immaculate Heart of Mary Parish through leading and managing a comprehensive strategy that outreaches, engages and evangelizes very intentionally middle school, high school age youth and families with adolescents as well as young adults. Additionally, this position would support and collaborate with the Confirmation sacramental program as well as other already established youth and young adult efforts within other groups/ministries of the parish. This is a full-time exempt position that will include mostly evenings and weekends.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

REQUIRED:

- Bachelor's Degree in Theology, Religious Studies or related field

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:

Primary duties and responsibilities include:

- Design and implement an outreach and evangelization strategy that considers the various efforts of Confirmation, Adolescents de la Esperanza and other parish groups.

- 4. Create and coordinate a communication plan for all parents, youth and young adults. A communication plan should engage, inform, and evangelize the various constituencies and their level of commitment.
- 5. Recruit, train, and empower volunteers to be facilitators, catechists, retreat leaders, peer leaders and mentors to the middle school, high school youth and young adults.
- 6. Ensure that all safe environment guidelines are being adhered to and in compliance with the implementation of The National Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.
- 7. Be aware and prepared to assist young people, their families and young adults in any pastoral care need that may arise from difficult topics and/or from personal sharing.
- Attend, participate and represent the parish at all approved diocesan gatherings for youth and at all diocesan leadership meetings.
- 9. Post regular and relevant content on social media accounts and web pages
- 10. Plan, prepare, implement, and manage the youth and young adult ministry program budget.
- 11. Manage data and process of evangelization for all participants; writing quarterly reports to pastor and diocesan related offices.
- 12. Perform other work-related tasks as assigned.
