Position Title: Director of Evangelization

**Job Classification:** Exempt, Fulltime (40 hours/week)

**Department:** Administration

Reports to: Pastor

**Pay Scale:** \$30.00/hour to \$40.00/hour depending on experience.

**Supervisory Responsibility:** Oversee and direct assigned staff members and volunteers as needed.

**Summary Overview:** Under the direction of the Pastor, this position plans, organizes, and directs the Evangelization initiatives, Faith Formation programs, liturgical life, and ministries of the parish. Additional responsibilities include direct support in strengthening the parish's mission in meetings and events with internal and external groups. Serves as a member of the parish's Senior Leadership Team.

### **REQUIRED FUNCTIONS**

- Ability to facilitate experiences, events, and encounters with Jesus Christ.
- Upholds and supports the vision, values, and mission of St. Joseph Catholic Church and School.
- Develops, directs, and implements all Evangelization initiatives, Faith Formation programs, and spiritually based programs, which includes bible studies, workshops, parish retreats, and educational seminars. (Collaborates with the pastor to provide adequate and sufficient programming.)
- Responsible for the assessment of needs, setting goals and priorities, and periodic evaluations of all Parish Faith Formation programs, including curriculum development and the selection of texts and materials.
- Directs and implements all liturgical and Sacramental celebrations of the parish.
- Oversees and maintains annual budgets for Faith Formation programs, including purchasing and expenditures.
- Prepares and submits annual departmental reports to Pastor and Diocesan administrators.
- Supports the Diocese of Orange Faith Formation Department by maintaining policies and programs, and by attending workshops, seminars, and meetings, as requested.
- Leads, develops, and evaluates leadership skills among Evangelization, Faith Formation, and Liturgy staff members, leaders, and volunteers.
- Executes Hospitality of parish events including staff events, Liturgical receptions, ministry needs, PSA, Dinner, and Parish Missions.

- Oversee, schedule, and provide ongoing direction, training, and formation to all ministries, including Evangelization initiatives, Liturgical life, and Faith Formation.
- Collaborates with the Parish Safe Environment Coordinator to ensure adherence to the Safe Environment Training and Diocesan Fingerprinting protocols of all adult catechists and volunteers.
- Collaborates with Parish Communications Coordinator to promote Faith Formation and all aspects of Parish Life.
- Assumes additional responsibilities and activities after mutual discussion and agreement with Pastor/Administrator, Parochial Vicar, and/or Business Manager.
